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Notes:

1. The School of Art offers FA 1020 – Mathematics in Art which can be taken to fulfil this requirement. See the General Academic Regulations Section of the Undergraduate Calendar for a full list of courses that meet this requirement.
2. The School of Art offers FAAH 2930 – Writing About Art which can be taken to fulfil this requirement. See the General Academic Regulations Section of the Undergraduate Calendar for a full list of courses that meet this requirement.
3. Students who wish to take a lighter course load in their first year are recommended to take their Written English and Mathematics Requirement courses in year two. These requirements should be completed within the first 60 credit hours of the program.
4. The prerequisite to enter STDO 4810 and STDO 4910 is year 4 of the program (minimum of 93 credit hours completed toward degree) and 15 credit hours of STDO courses at the 3000 level. Therefore students should make sure to take enough studio electives at the 3000 level in years two and three. Students in the three year General degree can request to transfer to the four year Honours degree after completion of 63 credit hours in the program. Students in BFA Honours Studio must obtain a minimum grade of B for STDO 4810 (Senior Studio 1), STDO 4820 (Senior Studio 2), STDO 4910 (Honours Seminar 1) and STDO 4920 (Honours Seminar 2).
5. In year four of the program many students prefer to take a lighter course load and focus on their Senior Studios and Honours Seminars. To do so they must take their fourth year Studio and Academic Elective components earlier, either in a summer term or in years two and three. Note that course availability is more limited in the summer terms.
6. Students who completed any of the following formerly offered courses should contact the Student Advisor in the School of Art for clarification as to how these courses can be used to meet the current requirements. Formerly offered courses: STDO 1200 Fundamentals of Drawing (9 cr. Hrs.); STDO 1220 Basic Design (9 cr. Hrs.); STDO 1430 Art Now (1.5 cr. Hrs.); STDO 1230 Drawing: Figure Study 1 (1.5 cr. Hrs.).
7. Students who completed the previously offered FA 1270 Health Hazards in the Arts will graduate with an additional 1 credit hour, for a total of 124 credit hours.

Definitions

Art History Elective

Can be fulfilled by any Art History course taught by the School of Art, listed under the code FAAH. In addition to the courses taught by the School of Art, the following courses from other faculties fulfil the Art History elective requirements. Not all courses are taught every year.

CLAS 2670 Greek Art and Archaeology (3 cr. Hrs.)

RLGN 2570 Indian Religious Art and Architecture (3 cr. Hrs.)

CLAS 2680 Roman Art and Archaeology (3 cr. Hrs.)

TXSC 2420 History of Textiles (3 cr. Hrs.)

Studio Elective

Can be fulfilled by any Studio course taught by the School of Art, listed under the code STDO. (Note that 15 credit hours of 3000 level studio courses must be completed prior to entrance in the 4000 level required courses, see note 4 for details.)

Academic Elective

Can be fulfilled by any course. This includes courses from another faculty, Studio courses or Art History courses.
